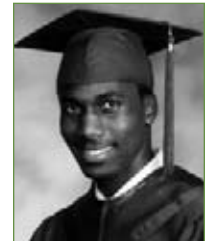
Kevin Warner

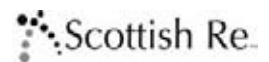


Meishka Zuill
